Birch and Connie Champeon

The Champeons serve under Unfolding Word, a bible translation ministry that utilizes local churches in several parts of the world to bring the bible to unreached people groups. Birch and Connie mentor local translators, providing both reusable translation tools and linguistic support. They have two grown children, Warren and Rowan.

Prayer Requests:

- A heavy training schedule is in process. All the training they currently have scheduled is new and in development. This is probably their largest prayer concern over the next 6 weeks.
