When "Church" Gets in the Way of the Church

Everyone has that roll of tape or piece of sticky tack or lint roller that has been sitting in a drawer, collecting every particle of dust, paper clip, shred of paper, and little pieces of plastic that broke off other things on its surface. It gets so weighted down that its ability to do its intended job is severely restricted.

When an institution has been around for awhile, it picks up a lot of extra bits and pieces that are glommed on over time. After 2,000 years, the church has picked up a *lot* of extra baggage. Our expectations for how church will be, what services "have to" exist, the function of certain spaces, and a thousand other variables come into play. "Church" has so many moving parts, so many different versions of the "right way" that it is difficult to cut through everything and get to the core mission of the church.

In Colossians 1:15–23, the apostle Paul reduces the Church to its most basic concepts:

- Jesus is the image of the invisible God, the Sovereign of all creation (vv 15–17).
- The Church is his body, of which he is the head, so He is preeminent (v 18).
- Everything about us is brought to its full reconciliation and peace in Him (vv 19–20).
- ♦ He is at work in all of us to make us holy and faithful (vv 21–23).
- And all of this is so we can clearly, directly proclaim the Gospel to all of creation (v 23).

Seems pretty clear, doesn't it? Anything that gets in the way of Jesus being manifest in us, even "church as usual," is detrimental to the mission and nature of the church.
