# WHAT IS A STEWARD?

The English word steward comes from an Old English word sti, which means "house," and weard, which means someone who looked toward something. A steward was literally a guard who kept those in his lord's house safe from harm or loss. The same meaning exists in the Hebrew and Greek words translated as steward in the Bible.
