



## Discussion Questions

2:1–10

**How does the domination of “the prince of the power of the air” contrast with the sovereignty of Christ in the preceding verses (1:19–23)?**

*Do you think the powers of this world still have power over believers, even though they have been saved? (Discuss different ways we might view this in the group.)*

**Paul emphasizes the difference between death in sin and life in grace (vv 5–7). As a Christian, do you see differences between your life now and your state before coming to Christ?**

*Taking the time to remind the Ephesians of their life in Christ indicates that we need to be reminded. Do you have things you do to remind you of Christ’s grace? How do they help you in your daily walk?*

**The emphasis on our salvation being “his workmanship” as opposed boasting in our own works seems fairly important to Paul (vv 8–9). Do our works for our own purposes sometimes look like the good works God has prepared for us?**

*Is there a way to tell the difference in your own actions? What about in the actions of others?*
