3:14–21

This section is *loaded* with superlative phrases to express the inexpressible nature of God’s work and presence. Take a minute to discuss all these phrases and why Paul chooses to pile them up like he does.

What do you do when you struggle to express the scale of God’s grace and power? Have you found someone or something that “resonates” with you, expressing what you cannot express?

If you have experienced this kind of overwhelming struggle to express, how would you explain it to someone who has not?

What does it mean to be “rooted and grounded in love” (v 17) and why is it important for the believer?

Verse 20 is really the end of Paul’s opening salvo, which is why it ends with “Amen!” If you had to summarize his argument from 1:15 to 4:21 in one sentence, what would it be?
